(A) Eligibility Criteria :-

1. Applicant should have completed 18 years of age.
 2. Minimum educational qualification should be at least 10th standard pass.
 3. Applicant should be a permanent resident of the place where the halt station is situated. If as local residence if it is located within the same district, which the station is located.
 4. Applicant should be fit for the active service and free from any communicable disease.
 5. Applicant should bear good character & should not have any criminal records.
- Applicant has to submit following certificates / documents with application in support**
1. School leaving certificate indicating date of birth.
 2. Educational qualification certificates.
 3. Two recent pass port size photographs of applicant.
 4. Physical fitness certificate from the Government doctor.
 5. Character certificate from local police authority regarding not having any criminal records.
 6. Certificate of local Gram Panchayat/Municipal authority proof of permanent resident of the place where the halt station is situated.

(B) Terms and conditions:-

- (1) The initial period of contract should be five years. It may be extended for the further period subject to contractor's working being satisfactory and Railway's dues being paid in time.
- (2) The successful applicant has to deposit to security deposit to the sum of Rs. 2000/- per month before commencement of contract. Quantum of deposit will be reviewed after the first year.
- (3) The appointment is purely contractual in nature and no facilities viz. abolition of regularisation of service, bonus, railway pass, facilities etc. shall accrue to the halt agent.
- (4) Payment of Commission:- As per the existing Railway. Board's letter no.2017/TG/18.11.2019, commission will be given to the halt agent on the amount of monthly tickets sold.

- (5) Halt agent should be given additional responsibility of cleanliness of Halt station with the halt agent.
- (6) A selection committee will scrutinize applications and short list eligible applications. Selection of halt agent will be based on the suitability of candidates and other factors.
