

Page No. 2 (Point no. 4,6,7 & 8)	Sir, NIT was floated on 07.08.2023 & pre bidding meeting was done today on 18.08.2023, considering the bad weather conditions here in HP (connectivity is a concern for us) it is requested to extend it by 10 days or week at least	Keeping in view natural calamities, particularly in Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand, last date of submission of bid is being extended by one week i.e. <b>11.9.2023</b>
2.	Page No. 2, Pt No. 8 & 9	Sir, we are registered under MSME (under Small Services) Kindly exempt EMD & document fee	Provision is already there on Page 8 (Para 6) of referred RFP
3.	Page No. 29 (point no 8,9, & 10) (ANNEXURE-3)	Sir, we are also registered with other Government banks & in the empanelment process of same these docs were asked from us on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper after our company empanelment confirmation. Can't we submit it after empanelment (if done) as we are a limited company & we have to take approvals & signatures for same @ different hierarchical levels which is a time taking process we can submit a temporary undertaking for same?	Non-Disclosure Agreement & Integrity Pact is to be submitted on Non Judicial Stamp invariably while submitting the Bid.
4.	Page No. 27 (ANNEXURE- 2)	We are registered under MSME so the EMD amount is exempted so should we fill in Annexure 2 or keep it empty?	Provision is already there on Page 8 (Para 6) of referred RFP If anyone is eligible for exemption, enclose the relevant documents seeking exemption from EMD.
5.	Page No. 54	Please give Bidder prefer zone wise option (for one or more zones) according to the location of the company & its subsidiaries. i.e., Priority wise: Zone A, Zone B or Zone C as per the individual capacity of that company the company can tick one or more preferred zones because it is not possible for a single company to cover @ PAN India level considering all the factors like quantum of e – waste generated from individual bank branch, transportation cost, labor charges etc.	This process is to empanel the vendor for disposal of e-waste. As per availability of e-waste, concerned ZCC/RCC will call quotations from all empanelled vendors.  Empanelled vendors will have to respond in terms of Point no. 7.8 (Page 9) of the RFP.
